Treasurer Report

- 1. Thank you to all who helped with our first Designer Bag Bingo. Net profit was \$11,623.85.
- 2. Our net revenue as of 2/7/2024 is \$16, 776.39. This includes "paying back" the \$6,000 deficit from last year.
- 3. Estimated upcoming expenses of approximately \$21,000 (Ensembles, Jazz Band, Senior Scholarships, and misc. Operational expenses).
- 4. We are in great right now, but let's keep the fundraising going!

President

- 1. Designer Bag Bingo Event seems to have been a huge success. Any thoughts/ideas for improvements for next year.
 - a. 5-10 baskets for a raffle
 - b. Start with a bag in the "second chance raffle" to get that going from the start
 - c. 50-50 and raffle ticket stubs should be saved
 - d. Alternate seating for those who require it (alternate to the "stools" attached to the tables)
 - e. Please send us any other ideas you have
- 2. Spring Banquet
 - a. Solicitation of donations has begun
 - b. We need a list of volunteers willing to help the chairs make phone calls, pick up donations, help make baskets let us know if you can help us out
 - c. Goal is to sell at least 200 tickets. Ticket sales will be opened to the band families first, then opened to the public a week later.
 - d. If we can sell at least 200 tickets, Marco's will allow us to have the restaurant space downstairs in addition to the banquet hall.
 - e. We will be sending out a Sign Up Genius for basket donations from band families (this is in addition to the solicitation from businesses that is being done)
 - f. We will again be having the Wine Wall \$10 gets you a "blind grab" bottle of wine
- 3. Other upcoming fundraisers
 - a. Clothing Drive on April 13th one week after spring break. Collection will hopefully be at Cherokee.
 - b. 2nd Annual Cornhole Tournament at Racks in Atco on May 18th, 1-4 PM. Racks will give us a portion of the food sales.

 - c. to chair the Sponsorships/Program Book Ads (starting May/June)
